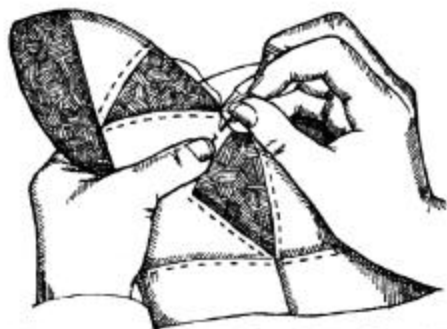


“Young At Heart” Women Give From the Heart
